

OHIO TOWNSHIP VACANCY BOARD MEETING

April 21, 2026

CALLING THE MEETING TO ORDER – The special meeting of the Ohio Township Vacancy Board was called to order by Luke Miller, on Monday, April 21, 2026 at the Ohio Township Municipal Park at 7:31 pm.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Luke Miller asked the secretary to note the presence of supervisors Cesar Cenicerros and Brian Krul, and vacancy chair Luke Miller. It is noted that Township Manager Justin Klingenberg and Township Building Official Joseph Jackson, and Solicitor Michael Witherel were also in attendance.

PURPOSE OF THE MEETING – Special meeting to fill a vacancy on the Board of Supervisors. The Board failed to fill the position within 30 days. Solicitor Witherel summarized the events that led to this meeting.

CONSIDERATION OF CANDIDATES –

Vice-Chairman Cesar Cenicerros nominated Jonathan Zwierzynski and Supervisor Brian Krul nominated Beau Blazer.

DELIBERATION AND VOTE – Cesar Cenicerros made a motion to vote on Jonathan Zwierzynski to fill the vacant seat on the Ohio Township Board of Supervisors. Cesar Cenicerros and Luke Miller both voted aye and Brian Krul voted nay. The motion carried 2-1.

Following the vote, Supervisor Brian Krul read a statement with the reasoning for his objection and nay vote.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business, Luke Miller made a motion, seconded by Cesar Cenicerros to adjourn the meeting. The motion was carried unanimously.
